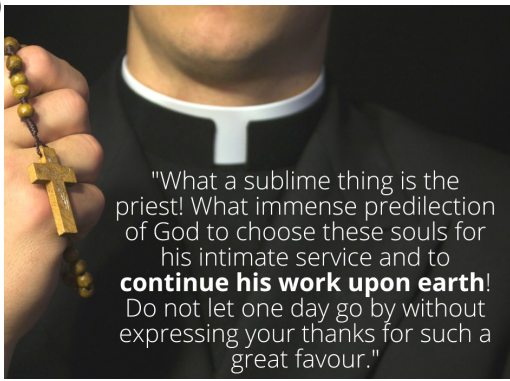

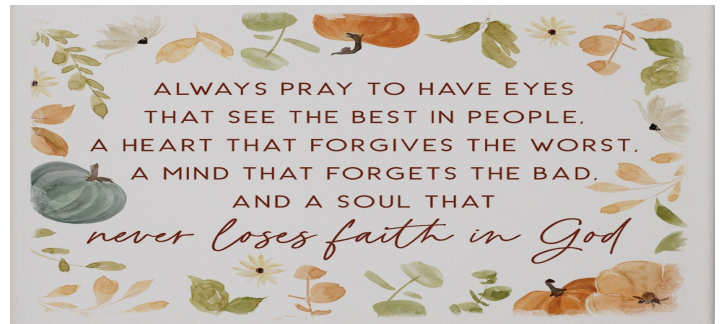

Stewardship Reflections: 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time *“My child, remember that you received what was good during your lifetime, while Lazarus likewise received what was bad; but now he is comforted here, whereas you are tormented. Moreover, between us and you a great chasm is established...”* LUKE 16:25-26
