Prayer Changes Things: Let Us Pray

for Peace: Will you gather your family for 10 minutes a day to pray one decade of the Rosary? The Rosarv is a Scripture-based prayer. It begins with the Apostles' Creed, which summarizes the great mysteries of our Catholic faith. The Our Father, which introduces each mystery, is from the Gospels. The first part of the Hail Mary is the angel's words announcing Christ's birth and Elizabeth's greeting to Mary and the second part is asking Mary to pray for us. The mysteries of the Rosary center on the events of Christ's life. The repetition in the Rosary is meant to lead us into restful prayer, providing guidance to situations that we face. The gentle repetition of the words helps us to enter into the silence of our hearts, where Jesus dwells.
